**Amendments to Scholar Handbook:**

Page 26, paragraph 2:

Personal Electronic Devices (PEDs) MUST BE TURNED OFF, and turned in to the main office during the day. PED's may not be used or visible in any classroom or non-classroom setting, including hallways, stairways or stairwells, offices, courtyards, the auditorium, the gym, or the parking lot at any time. Cell phones may not be used on campus at any time between the hours of 7:30AM and 5:45PM. Students may use cell phones outside of school buildings for the purposes of communicating with parents before 7:30 AM or after 5:45 PM.

Page 26, paragraph 4:

If a student uses or displays a cell phone, electronic music player, headphones, or personal video game console during class time, hall passing time, or inside of any building or during the specified times of prohibition, the following consequence(s) will result:

Confiscation of the device by a staff member.

- ANY OFFENSE: The device **will not** be returned to the student. It will be given to a parent/guardian or authorized adult who comes to pick it up from the main office. Students **will not** be authorized to pick up or receive the device. Devices confiscated under this section will be subject to a 7-day confiscation or \$10 administrative fee at the parents discretion.

I have received, read, understand and agree to abide by the KIPP University Prep High School Scholar Handbook for the 2011-2012 school year. I understand that my child will be held accountable for the behavior expectations and disciplinary consequences outlined in the Handbook and as determined by administration. I understand that the Scholar Handbook governs all behavior at school, school-sponsored and school-related activities, school-sponsored travel, some designated behaviors occurring within 300 feet of school, some designated behaviors occurring off-campus, and for any school-related misconduct regardless of time or location. I understand that a referral for criminal prosecution is possible for certain violations of law.
